Merchant Guidelines & Rules for Trick or Treat on Mission Avenue Participation

- All participants need to register by Monday, October 14th at https://midlandscommunity.org/bellevue-community-foundation-trick-or-treat-event/
- \$10 participation fee will secure your spot and handle marketing, portable restrooms and other activities.
- Provide enough candy or treats for 2500 kids or more.
- If you do not have a storefront in the blocked off area, you may bring a tent (10×10 is preferred), table/chairs, or vehicle to pass out treats from.
- No electricity hookup will be provided. Participants are welcome to bring their own small/quiet generator.
- Participants will be allowed to start setting up at 3:30pm on October 20th and stay setup until 6pm or until your treats run out.
- This event will include a few food trucks/vendors that have received city permits. No other participants will be permitted to sell any product or service at this event. Handing out flyers, business cards, coupons or other business swag is acceptable.
- This year, we will be accepting non-perishable food donations for the Bellevue Food Pantry. Participants will be able to drop off these donations along the route at the Bellevue Eagles, Olde Town Tavern, and the Century Lounge during the event.
